Fees are charged for services rendered for the United States only for records searches, photocopies, and electronic access to case information databases. No fees under this schedule are charged to federal agencies funded from judiciary appropriations.

## **PHOTOCOPIES**

- \$ .50 Per page. *(Fee applies to copies of (i) original documents, (ii) microfiche/microfilm reproductions of original records. This fee shall apply to services rendered on behalf of the United States if the record or paper is available through electronic access)*
- \$ .10 Per page printed from public access terminals.

## **MICROFICHE/MICROFILM**

- \$5 Per microfiche film sheet or microfilm jacket copy of court records, if available.

## **MAGNETIC TAPE RECORDINGS**

- \$26 Per recording, either reel to reel or cassette, including the cost of the materials.

## **ARCHIVED CASE FILE RETRIEVAL**

- \$45 Per shipment. *(For retrieval of a record from a Federal Records Center, National Archives, or other storage location removed from the place of business of the court)*

## **RETURNED CHECKS**

- \$45 Checks made payable to the court that are returned for lack of funds

## **ATTORNEY ADMISSION**

- \$150 Admission to practice in the District of Utah
- \$15 Pro Hac Vice Admission
- \$15 Annual Court Bar Registration
- \$15 Duplicate certificate of admission or certificate of good standing

## **DISTRICT COURT RULES OF PRACTICE**

- \$15 Tabbed looseleaf edition
- \$5 Tabbed paperbound edition

## **REGISTRY FUND ACCOUNTS**

Handling fee of ten (10) percent of interest earned for registry fund accounts that, pursuant to court order, are deposited by the court into interest-bearing accounts. *(Fee assessed from interest earnings in accordance with fee schedule issued by the Director, Administrative Office of the U.S. Courts)*

## **ELECTRONIC ACCESS TO CASE INFORMATION DATABASES**

- \$.07 Per page charge for viewing case information on this system. *(Use of WebPACER requires users to register with the Clerk. Fees are invoiced quarterly. Fee applies to all users -- private/public/state/federal, except as noted in the introductory paragraph. The court, for good cause, may exempt persons or classes of persons from these fees, in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to such information.)*
