IN THE MATTER OF THE ADOPTION OF INTERIM LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULES IMPLEMENTING THE SMALL BUSINESS REORGANIZATION **ACT OF 2019**

General Order No. 20-004

On August 23, 2019, the President signed the Small Business Reorganization Act of 2019 ("SBRA") with an effective date of February 19, 2020. The SBRA creates a Subchapter V under Chapter 11 to facilitate the reorganization of small businesses through the bankruptcy process. To implement the SBRA, the Advisory Committee on Bankruptcy Rules promulgated interim rules that were published for national comment and approved by the Judicial Conference of the United States to be adopted as local rules by the bankruptcy courts ("SBRA Interim Rules"). The SBRA Interim Rules will be withdrawn after similar amendments can made to the Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure under the normal Rules Enabling Act process. The Court has reviewed the proposed SBRA Interim Rules. Accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Utah Bankruptcy Court shall adopt by general order the SBRA Interim Rules as part of its Local Rules with an effective date of February 19, 2020. The Utah Bankruptcy Court shall publish such rules to the Bar and to the public.
