

GENERAL ORDER
10-002
BY DEPUTY CLERK

Title 28, United States Code, Section 1871 (b)(2) and (3), provides that a petit juror who is required to attend more than ten (10) days of actual petit jury service (including days of travel) or a grand juror required to attend more than forty-five (45) days of actual grand jury service (including days of travel), may be paid an additional fee not exceeding \$10.00 more than the attendance fee for each day in excess of the ten (10) days of actual petit jury service or forty-five (45) days of actual grand jury service, unless the presiding judge determines in his or her discretion that such enhanced fees are not appropriate and directs that they not be paid. Therefore;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that in the District of Utah grand jurors serving in excess of forty-five (45) days and petit jurors serving in excess of the (10 days) of actual jury service (including days of travel) shall receive an increase of attendance fees of \$10.00 for each day present (or in travel status) until such petit or grand juror is excused, unless the presiding judge determines in his or her discretion that such enhanced fees are not appropriate and directs that they not be paid.
