
In fulfillment of the court's obligation to promote judicial economy and the orderly working of the judiciary, the following case-management procedures are established to address the large number of cases related to *United States v. RaPower-3, LLC, et al.*, Case No. 2:15-cv-00828-DN-EJF, that the court anticipates will be filed. The objective of this Order is to streamline procedures, avoid duplication of work, combine similar hearings, avoid inconsistent decisions, and promote judicial economy.

Accordingly, pursuant to DUCivR 83-2(a)(2), **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that all currently pending cases filed by Receiver R. Wayne Klein arising from or relating to *United States v. RaPower-3, LLC, et al.*, Case No. 2:15-cv-00828-DN-EJF, shall be reassigned to District Judge David Nuffer.

IT IS FURTHER HEREBY ORDERED that all future cases filed by Receiver R. Wayne Klein arising from or relating to *United States v. RaPower-3, LLC, et al.*, Case No. 2:15-cv-00828-DN-EJF, shall be directly assigned to District Judge David Nuffer.
