**GENERAL ORDER**

No. 17-007

**Contents of Pretrial Services Report.** As permitted in Guide Vol. 8A, Chapter 1, §170(e), the court directs that a Pretrial Services Report shall address rebuttable presumptions and potential penalties.

**Distribution of Pretrial Services Reports.** A written pretrial services report shall, whenever possible, be presented to the magistrate judge and made available to defense counsel and the government at the defendant's first court appearance. Pretrial services reports are confidential, subject to the limitations and exceptions of 18 U.S.C. § 3153(c), and must be returned to the pretrial services officer at the close of any hearing. Defense counsel and the attorney for the government may, however, retain the criminal history attachment of the pretrial services report, and permit staff to review it for purposes of guidelines calculations, but must not disclose it to any other person without an order of the court.
