**Intra-District Travel of
District and Magistrate Judges**

General Standing Order 2008-2

The Court having an interest in promoting programs designed to provide education and training that will increase public awareness of the functions, purposes, and operations of the court, and finding that federal judicial appropriated funds are not generally made available for this purpose, desires to encourage its judges and magistrate judges to speak at public and private venues within the State of Utah.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall pay for such travel described above from the Court Fund:

EXCEPTION: A judge may be reimbursed from appropriated funds for travel to visit a penal institution or youth center.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall pay for visits to penal institutions or youth centers from appropriated funds.

This General Standing Order acts as Advance Authorization for all travel herein described.
