IN RE: UPDATED PROTOCOL REGARDING FACE MASKS AT THE ORRIN G. HATCH COURTHOUSE

GENERAL ORDER

No. 21-010

The Court continues to evaluate its response to the spread of the COVID-19 virus and recognizes the need to assist in the preservation of public safety and health while effectively administering justice within the Orrin G. Hatch Courthouses during this period of national emergency. In recognition of the Centers for Disease Control's recent recommendation that all Americans—regardless of vaccination status—wear masks in indoor public places, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. this Order supersedes <u>General Order 21-008</u>, which allowed vaccinated individuals to be in public areas of the Orrin G. Hatch Courthouse without wearing a mask; and
- 2. effective immediately, an individual entering the Orrin G. Hatch Courthouse must wear a mask over their nose and mouth in all public areas inside the courthouse.
