GENERAL ORDER 22-020

Under DUCivR 83-7.6, the District Court has reviewed the 2022 proposed amendments to the Local Rules of Practice of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Utah, which were published for comment. Chief Judge Marker notified the District Court on October 27, 2022, that Bankruptcy Judges agreed to advance the proposed amendments to the District Court for review. By a majority vote of the district judges on November 4, 2022, the proposed amendments were approved.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the 2022 proposed amendments to the Local Rules of Practice of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Utah are approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Bankruptcy Court must, by entering its own general order, adopt the amended local bankruptcy rules and publish the rules on its website to the Bar and public.
