REINSTATEMENT FEES

GENERAL ORDER
No. 23-006

Consistent with Section V.C. of the Court's Attorney Admission Fund Management Plan, the Court has reviewed and evaluated the attorney admission-related fees. Specifically, downward adjustments to the registration lapsed and pro hac vice fees are necessary to avoid unreasonable accumulation of funds in the Attorney Admission Fund. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that Annual Attorney Registration Fee for the 2023-2024 registration year shall be \$30.00.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that effective June 1, 2023, the pro hac vice fee shall be \$50.00.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that effective June 1, 2023, the reinstatement fee under DUCivR 83-1.2(d)(2) shall be \$75.00. Active and federal attorneys who fail to register by July 1, 2023, will be unable to electronically file documents in this court as of July 2, 2023, their membership status will be changed to registration lapsed, and they will be required to pay the reinstatement fee before their membership will be reactivated.

The Court directs the Advisory Committee on the Local Rules of Practice to amend DUCivR 83-1.2(d)(2) when the local rules are next amended to permit the reinstatement fee to be set by General Order.
