GENERAL ORDER

Pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 154(b), it is hereby


ORDERED that the active United States Bankruptcy Judge senior in continuous active service upon the bankruptcy bench who has not already served as Chief Judge of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Utah shall be designated as the Chief Judge of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Utah. The term of service shall be five years.

The Chief Judge of the Bankruptcy Court shall perform the statutory duties outlined in 28 U.S.C. § 154, including ensuring the rules of the bankruptcy court and of the district court are observed and that the business of the bankruptcy court is handled effectively. The Chief Judge of the Bankruptcy Court shall oversee the administration and budget of the bankruptcy court and shall work with the Chief Judge of the District Court to ensure that courts have sufficient resources for court operations.

The Honorable Joel T. Marker is designated as Chief Judge of the Bankruptcy Court with his term commencing on September 4, 2020.
