STANDING ORDER

No. 16-003

Pursuant to the discretion of the Court and the Court's obligation to promote judicial economy and the orderly working of the judiciary, and based on agreement between the Office of the Federal Public Defender and the U.S. Attorney's Office for the District of Utah, the Court establishes the following scheduling order to address the large number of motions that have been recently filed under 28 U.S.C. § 2255 in light of *Johnson v. United States*, 135 S. Ct. 2551 (2015) ("*Johnson* motions").

A total of 205 *Johnson* motions have been filed with the Court by the Office of the Federal Public Defender for the District of Utah, CJA counsel, and *pro se* petitioners. Pursuant to the Court's Standing Order No. 16-002, 128 of those cases have been stayed.¹ Of the 77 cases that have not been stayed, six cases have been resolved,² two cases have already been briefed by the United States,³ and twenty cases are proceeding *pro se*.⁴ This Standing Order establishes a standard briefing schedule in the remaining 49 cases which are not stayed.⁵

In order to prepare a sufficient response to each of the pending *Johnson* motions, the United States has already ordered copies of the presentence reports; the Court's statement of reasons; and the sentencing transcripts in the underlying criminal case. While most presentence reports and statement of reasons have already been received, it will take some time for the court reporters to transcribe each of the 49 sentencing hearings. Upon receiving the sentencing transcript, the United States is entitled to a reasonable period of time to file its response to the motion, and defense counsel is entitled to a reasonable time to reply.

Unless a more specific briefing schedule is set by the assigned judge, the following briefing schedule shall apply:

- In *Johnson* motions that appear to challenge the application of the Armed Career Criminal Act (listed in Attachment C), the United States shall have 21 days to respond from the date the sentencing transcript is filed with the Court. The defense will then have 30 days in which to file a reply or a notice that no reply will be filed.
- In *Johnson* motions that appear to challenge the application of the United States Sentencing Guidelines (listed in Attachment D), the United States will file on or before July 22, 2016, motions to stay pending the U.S. Supreme Court's decision in *Beckles v. United States* (S. Ct. No. 15-8544). The parties have stipulated to such a stay in the cases identified with an asterisk in Attachment D. As to the remaining cases, should the assigned judge deny the motion to stay, the United States' response shall be due 21 days from the date the stay is denied or the date the sentencing transcript is filed with the

Court, whichever is later. The defense will then have 30 days in which to file a reply or a notice that no reply will be filed.

- In *Johnson* motions that appear to challenge another statutory provision (listed in Attachment E), the United States shall have 60 days to respond from the date the sentencing transcript is filed with the Court. The defense will then have 30 days in which to file a reply or a notice that no reply will be filed.
- In accordance with Standing Order 16-002, “[w]hen precedential rulings are entered that resolve issues for the cases within a given category, the Federal Defender’s Office will either move to withdraw similar pending motions or will supplement them with a more detailed pleading, asking that the stay be lifted and fully explaining the *Johnson* claim.” If the motion to lift the stay is granted, those cases will then be covered by this Standing Order.

If the provisions of this Standing Order are more favorable than the specific briefing schedule already ordered in a particular case, either party may seek relief from the assigned judge. In addition, either party may file a motion with the assigned judge to extend or expedite the briefing schedule established in this Standing Order based on the circumstances of the case.


Administratively, the process shall work as follows:

- The Clerk of the Court will direct entry in the docket as follows:
 - For all cases listed in Attachment C where no alternative briefing schedule is set by the assigned judge: “Pursuant to Standing Order 16-003, upon the filing of the sentencing transcript with the Court, the United States shall have 21 days to respond to the motion to vacate. Not later than 30 days after the response is filed, the defense shall file a reply or a notice that no reply will be filed.”

- For all cases marked with an asterisk in Attachment D: “Case stayed per Standing Order 16-003.”
- For all other cases listed in Attachment D where no alternative briefing schedule is set by the assigned judge: “Pursuant to Standing Order 16-003, upon the filing of the sentencing transcript with the Court or upon the denial of the United States’ motion to stay pending *Beckles*, whichever is later, the United States shall have 21 days to respond to the motion to vacate. Any reply must be filed by the defense within 30 days after the filing of the response.”
- For all cases listed in Attachment E where no alternative briefing schedule is set by the assigned judge: “Pursuant to Standing Order 16-003, upon the filing of the sentencing transcript with the Court, the United States shall have 60 days to respond to the motion to vacate. Not later than 30 days after the response is filed, the defense shall file a reply or a notice that no reply will be filed.”
- When a sentencing transcript is completed, the court reporter will file the transcript with the Court, triggering the established deadlines.
