
GENERAL ORDER

No. 17-004

Pursuant to the discretion of the Court and in the interests of judicial economy, it is ordered that attorneys employed by the Office of the Federal Public Defender for the District of Arizona and assigned to the Capital Habeas Unit, who are not members of the Bar of the State of Utah, may be admitted to practice before this Court for the purpose of representing Utah prisoners sentenced to death in habeas corpus proceedings pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254 and related litigation. Such attorneys must comply with the requirements of DUCivR83-1.1(g).
