The United States District Court having an interest in activities and functions that will benefit the bench and the bar in the administration of justice and finding that federal judicial appropriated funds are not generally made available for this purpose, desires to encourage its district judges, magistrate judges, clerk, and chief deputy to attend Utah State Bar Meetings, Federal Bar Association, or American Bar Association.


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall pay for such travel described above from the Court Fund:

EXCEPTION: A judge may be reimbursed from appropriated funds for travel if the judge has been designated by the Chief Judge of a Court of Appeals to serve as an official spokesperson for the judiciary at a meeting or convention.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall pay for such an exception from appropriated funds.

This General Standing Order acts as an advance authorization for all travel herein described.
