GENERAL ORDER
26-006

In cases involving law students working with CJA counsel in cooperation with the Federal Criminal Practicum at Brigham Young University College of Law and S.J. Quinney College of Law, the court authorizes payment for services provided by the law students pursuant to Guide to Judiciary Policy, Volume 7, Chapter 3, § 320.70.10, up to the current statutory maximum rate set by the Administrative Office in Chapter 3, § 310.20.10(a), without prior approval from the court. As of January 1, 2026, the statutory maximum is \$3,000. After services reach the statutory maximum, the CJA attorney must submit an authorization for additional funding.
