Pursuant to the provisions of the Criminal Justice Act, 18 U.S.C. §3006A(a)(1) and (c), the Federal Public Defender for the District of Utah is hereby appointed to represent defendants in cases from the District of Utah who previously qualified for appointment of counsel and whose cases arose out of West Valley City, Utah, or whose cases were impacted by prior convictions out of West Valley City, Utah, for purposes of evaluating any possible post-conviction claims or remedies which may be available, pursuing available post-conviction remedies on behalf of the defendants or assisting said defendants in seeking appointment of CJA counsel from the Magistrate Judges.
