IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the full-time magistrate judge most senior in active service who has not already served as Chief Magistrate Judge be appointed to serve as Chief Magistrate Judge for a five year term. The Chief Magistrate Judge shall serve as a liaison between the magistrate judges and district judges on administrative matters. The Chief Magistrate Judge shall also be the primary point of contact for magistrate judges with the clerk of court and other court offices such as Pretrial Services, the Probation Office, the United States Marshal's Office, the United States Attorney's Office, the Office of the Federal Defender and the CJA panel, as well as local law enforcement agencies and bar associations.

Additional duties include but are not limited to:

- 1. Chair of the Criminal Coordinating Committee;
- 2. Administration of the Criminal Justice Act Plan and the governing of the CJA Panel membership;
- 3. Overseeing the allocation and rotation of magistrate judge duties among the magistrate judges;
- 4. Coordinate the operations of specialty courts and programs staffed by magistrate judges; and
- 5. Promote uniformity in procedures among magistrate judges in the court.
